

Presentation of the slate of nominees for the Board of Directors

The members of the nominating committee are Henrik Blomquist (Chair), Bure Equity, Petter Stillström, AB Traction, Sven Zetterqvist, Livförsäkringsaktiebolaget Skandia, and Patrik Tigerschiöld (Chairman of the Board). The committee has proposed the following.

Patrik Tigerschiöld is to chair the annual general meeting.

Until the next annual general meeting, the Board is still to consist of seven members without deputies as elected by the annual general meeting. That does not include employee representatives, and the trade unions concerned have announced that all current members and deputies will be reappointed until the next annual general meeting.

Until the next general meeting, Board fees are to remain unchanged at 320,000 kronor for the Chairman and 160,000 kronor for each remaining member elected by the annual general meeting and not employed by the company (for a total of 1,280,000 kronor). Audit fees are to be payable as per approved invoice.

The 2009 annual general meeting reelected all Board members. In the view of the nominating committee, the Board functions in an effective and coordinated manner. Lennart Evrell and Tomas Bergström have both declined reelection by the 2010 annual general meeting. With that in mind, the committee is proposing the reelection of Patrik Tigerschiöld, Rune Glavare, Petter Stillström, Thomas Thuresson and Henrik Lange, as well as the election of Lotta Stalin and Andreas Bladh. The committee has nominated Patrik Tigerschiöld as Chairman of the Board. The slate of nominees is deemed to possess the diversity and breadth of expertise, experience and background required in view of the company's operations, stage of development and other circumstances.

Information about the two first-time nominees:

Lotta Stalin was born in 1954, has a Master of Engineering from Lund University of Technology, and has taken management training at the Stanford Graduate School of Business. She currently runs a consulting business. She was previously CEO of Kuusakoski Sverige AB, business area manager at FMV Logistik, business area manager and vice president at A/S Poolimon, production line manager at Electrolux and CEO of Överums Bruk. She is currently a member of the board of Nobia Group. She is independent of the company, its management and big shareholders.

Andreas Bladh was born in 1975 and has a Master of Engineering from the Royal Institute of Technology in Stockholm. He has been investment manager at Bure Equity AB since Skanditek Industriförvaltning AB (which merged with Bure in January 2010) employed him in 2005. He previously served as global manager for parts of the Atlas Copco Tools AB product offering. As an employee of Bure Equity, PartnerTech's largest shareholder, he is dependent on the company's big shareholders. He is independent of the company and its management. He holds 1,900 PartnerTech shares.

An assessment by the nominating committee has determined that the proposed composition of the Board meets the criteria for independence established by the Swedish Code of Corporate Governance and NASDAQ OMX Stockholm's Regulations for Issuers.
